MARTIN RESERVOIRS

Expansion work continues and the geotechnical drilling is complete. A Dam safety meeting is still needed.

Oak Meadows required more releases than previous years. This is likely due to a leak in the system. EPC and SGM are looking into the situation. Augmentation release should be completed for the season.

CNC Construction provided a quote for the boards consideration to dig out beaver dams and install cages around upstream end of pipes to prevent beavers from plugging them again.

Tom Jankowsky moved approval of the CNC Construction quote to deal with beavers; seconded by Richard L. McNeill; motion carried.

Work continues on the WaterSMART grant application. The deadline is October 31, 2023.
